

## How the irregularities of the teeth and jaws affect the face.

### Natural - Straight Profile

The normal face is characterized by a normal and harmonious relationship of the teeth and jaws

### Convex Profile

Class 2 malocclusion is characterized by what is commonly considered a receding lower jaw with protruding upper front teeth.

A Class 2 malocclusion with a receding lower jaw and the upper front teeth ripped back is called a Class 2 division ii malocclusion. 66% of all malocclusions are Class 2.

### Concave Profile

Class 3 malocclusion is characterized by the under development of the upper jaw and protruding lower teeth.
